<b>1 Year</b>	0-6 months: coos/babbles, uses different sounds, laughs  7-12 months: first true words  12 months: vocabulary of 3-5 words	0-6 months: awareness of sounds  12 months: recognizes own name, uses gestures (waving, reaching, etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not responding to name</li> <li>• Not making eye contact</li> <li>• Not using any true words</li> </ul>
<b>2 Years</b>	18 months: vocabulary of 10-20 words, requests verbally  24 months: Uses 2-3 word sentences, vocabulary of 300 words, uses consonants at the beginnings of words	18 months: Recognizes familiar people, pictures, and objects  24 months: understands questions, follows simple commands	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not putting 2 words together</li> <li>• Not using new words each week</li> <li>• Doesn't follow simple commands</li> <li>• Doesn't point to body parts</li> <li>• Not understood at least 50% of the time</li> </ul>
<b>3 Years</b>	1000 word vocabulary, 3-4 word sentences, names at least one color, at least 75% intelligible	36 months: follows 2 step commands, plays interactively with other children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limited vocabulary</li> <li>• Doesn't interact with other children</li> <li>• Doesn't follow 2-step directions</li> <li>• Not understood at least 75% of the time</li> </ul>
<b>4 Years</b>	Uses 4-5 word sentences, asks/answers simple "who", "what", "when", "where", and "why" questions, is understood by people outside of family, at least 85% intelligible	Follows 2-3 step commands, sits attentively for a story	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Doesn't ask/answer questions</li> <li>• Doesn't recall events from a story</li> <li>• Not understood at least 85% of the time</li> </ul>
<b>5 Years</b>	Uses 5-6 word sentences, can define objects by function, uses verb tenses, uses most sounds correctly	understands opposites, hears and understands most of what others say, uses adult-like grammar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Doesn't name some letters/numbers</li> <li>• Doesn't use detailed sentences</li> <li>• Doesn't communicate well with adults/children</li> <li>• Not understood at least 95% of the time</li> </ul>
